

## **Traffic Crash**

All standard traffic laws apply to motorists on campus just as they do off campus. Should you ever find yourself involved in a traffic accident on campus treat the situation as you would anywhere else.

First do not leave the scene contact the UCF Police or dial 9-1-1. When speaking with the operator try to provide as much information as possible about your location and notify the operator of any injuries so they can send the appropriate response.

Be sure to have your driver's license, proof of insurance, and vehicle registration with you when you are driving.
