

UCF Alert

The University of Central Florida has an emergency communication system in place called UCF Alert.

UCF Alert is made up of different notification tools like text messages, e-mails, outdoor sirens, and campus signs that will alert students, faculty, and staff to an emergency situation.

To receive the text messages and e-mails, students can update their contact information online by going to www.myucf.ucf.edu. Click on "Student Self-Service" and scroll down to the blue "Personal Information" heading in the center of the screen. Click on "UCF Alert" to update your contact information.

UCF employees can also update their information online by clicking on "Employee Self-Service".

UCF tests its emergency communication system several times a year to make sure that they are working properly. In case of an emergency on campus, UCF's main tool for communicating updates will be the University's website: www.ucf.edu. During an emergency the UCF Homepage will become an important informational resource for students, faculty, staff and their families. Keeping the UCF community safe is our number one concern.
