

Hazing

UCF provides many opportunities for students to become involved in a variety of activities on campus. They include student clubs, fraternities and sororities, sports teams, social groups and professional organizations.

Students should take comfort in knowing the UCF has no tolerance for hazing. Under UCF's Golden Rule hazing is defined as "any action or situation which recklessly or intentionally endangers mental or physical health and/or safety of a student for the purpose of initiation, admission, or association with an organization operated under the university". Hazing is the violation of university rules and can cause harm or your organization's suspension from campus. Hazing may also result in a violation of Florida State Statutes.

If you know of an organization, team, or group that has participated in hazing, it is important that you report it immediately.
